

Nursery Quick Facts

For your info:

- The nursery is for children up to age three. The area is divided into a toddler room (at the entrance) and a baby room just inside the theatre which provides a quieter area for nursing moms and babies.
- Due to the setup and cleaning of toys and equipment that is done every Sunday and to provide the safest environment possible, children will not be signed into the nursery until 10:15am.
- You will be asked to initial a sign-in sheet when dropping off your child. You will be provided with a number card which you will be asked to return to pick up your child. If for some reason you are needed in the nursery, the number on your card will appear at the bottom of the theatre screen.
- A small snack might be provided to toddlers (generally Goldfish crackers or arrowroot cookies). Please inform the nursery worker if your child has any allergies and whether you would like your child to be given a snack.
- Due to allergy concerns, no food is to be brought into the nursery (including snacks from the Well table).
- We ask that parents proceed to the nursery to sign out their children as soon as the service is over, as nursery workers must take down and pack up the nursery equipment immediately following the service.

For your peace of mind:

- All nursery workers go through a screening process involving a full background check, and there will be a minimum of two people on duty each week.
- All toys, mats and equipment are cleaned weekly with baby-friendly products and all blankets and change pads are washed weekly as well.
